Re: Deer Management

We write to inform you that, as in the past seven years, a deer management program will take place during the winter months of 2014. This program will be conducted in conjunction with cooperation from NYS Office of Parks, Recreation & Historic Preservation, the Seminary of the Immaculate Conception and the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation.

The deer population, unfortunately, has exploded and become a matter of public health, safety and environmental degradation. We take this problem very seriously and have taken steps to put in place a rigorous program which, we believe, will result in a far more controlled situation. As in past years, all venison will be processed and donated to Long Island food pantries, among them *Long Island Cares – The Harry Chapin Food Bank*.

If you hear anything of concern during the nighttime, please call the Lloyd Harbor Police (631-549-8220). They will be able to advise you either that culling is taking place, or investigate, as appropriate.
