

DEC BOW HUNTING SEASON

OCTOBER 1, 2014 - DECEMBER 31, 2014

The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) regulates hunting in New York State. In April 2014 the DEC reduced the bow hunting setback on private properties from 500 feet to 150 feet from any dwelling (unless hunter owns the dwelling or has permission of the owner).

DEC Licensing Requirements: An individual must have a basic NYS hunting license & bow privilege. Requirement includes a minimum of 24 hours of course work. Village Notice & Safety Requirements:

Please notify the Lloyd Harbor Police (549 – 8220) if you are going to have a bow hunter on your property. Additionally, please advise the LHPD as to the number of deer taken from your land.

Village Safety Requirements:

- 2 Acres – 1 licensed participant (Maximum)
- 4 Acres - 2 licensed participants (Maximum)
- 6 Acres - 3 licensed participants (Maximum)
- 8 Acres & over – 4 licensed participants (Maximum)

Note: Entrails/"gut piles" should be at least 100 feet from all boundaries and shielded from public view.
