IMPORTANT CAMP INFORMATION CHANGES FOR 2021

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> There will be no in person camp registration day for summer 2021.

All camp registration applications with payment must be dropped off at Lloyd Harbor Village Hall in the outside designated drop box.

Starting Monday, March 1 through Friday, March 5 the drop box will be available from 8 AM – 4 PM. This is the only time during the week that the drop box will be available.

Village Hall staff will NOT accept any forms/payments related to camp registration.

Any camp registration received after Friday, March 5 will be considered late and subject to an additional \$50 per week, per child late fee. Register between March 1-5 to avoid these additional charges.

All payments must be in the form of a check or money order ONLY (no cash payments will be accepted).

CAMP REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR LLOYD HARBOR RESIDENTS ONLY

<u>SUMMER CLUB PROGRAM</u> (Children ages 6 -- 10, entering Grades 1 -- 5 in September 2021):

• \$300 per camper, per week. For registrations received between March 1 – 5 only.

• \$350 per camper per week. For ALL registrations received AFTER March 5.

JUNIOR RECREATION PROGRAM (Children ages 10 – 13, entering Grades 6 -- 8 in September 2021):

• \$400 per camper, per week. For registrations received between March 1 – 5 only.

• \$450 per camper per week. For ALL registrations received AFTER March 5.

CAMP DATES: Monday, June 28 – Friday, August 20, 2021

DAYS & HOURS: Monday – Friday, 10 AM – 3 PM at Lloyd Harbor Village Park.

Due to COVID-19, there will be no camp held on inclement weather days. Inclement weather cancellations will be determined by 9:00 am.

No refunds will be given due to inclement weather cancellations.

REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN FOR ANY UNUSED CAMP TIME FOR ANY REASON. REGISTRATION FEE IS NOT REFUNDABLE AFTER A CHILD IS ENROLLED. WEEKS ENROLLED ARE NON-TRANSFERABLE.

PLEASE NOTE: Children must have the ability to function in an outdoor group setting with sandy, uneven terrain. Camp is not staffed to provide one-on-one attention. Please make sure your child is interested in and enthusiastic about these sorts of programs before registering. All activities depend on favorable weather.

REQUIRED CAMP REGISTRATION PAPERWORK

Completed Camp Registration / Emergency Contact Information Form (One per each child). Child's most recent medical exam (dated no earlier than 2020). Forms MUST include an updated list of immunizations & doctor's signature. All forms MUST be submitted by May 21, 2021. No child will be permitted to attend camp without proper documentation.

- \checkmark Please choose your camp weeks for each child carefully.
- ✓ Please make sure you complete the information on the Camp Registration form. (One form is required for each child).
- ✓ Please make sure you indicate your first and second choice of preferred camp weeks.
- Please make sure you sign and date the Recreation Program Release on the bottom of the Camp Registration Form.
- Please complete the Emergency Contact Information form (located on the back of the Camp Registration Form).
- ✓ Please make sure you check (and double check) that you are submitting the appropriate fee. (If you have multiple children attending camp, you may use one check for all your children).
- ✓ All payments must be made via check or money order. No cash payments will be accepted. Please make your check payable to: *Incorporated Village of Lloyd Harbor*

GUEST PARKING PERMITS

2021 Guest Parking Permit:\$10 Per Vehicle2 Permit Limit, Per Resident, Per DayGuest Passes may not be purchased by Lloyd Harbor residents without a valid 2021 parking permit.All guests must be accompanied by a Lloyd Harbor resident for entry into the park.Guest parking permit must be prominently displayed on the vehicle dashboard.***Note: On July 4, 2021 - No guest permits will be sold or honored after 7:30 PM.***

HARBOR USE / BOAT RACK PERMITS

All motorized watercraft using the Village Park ramp are required to have a permit sticker. Harbor Use Permits \$50 / Boat Rack Permits (for storage of kayaks & dinghies) \$40 Note: All boats / watercraft must be removed from the park by December 1, 2021

FAMILY PARTIES

All parties are subject to Lloyd Harbor Village Park regulations.

Party host must be a Lloyd Harbor resident in attendance and possess a valid 2021 parking permit.

For parties of more than 25 guests, a \$100 fee is payable in advance.

Guest parking permit rules apply to all vehicles of non-residents that will be in attendance.

No private parties of over 75 people are permitted. No parties are permitted on July 4th & Labor Day. You must call Genevieve Cimino, (631) 424-0051, at least 2 weeks before the event to make arrangements.

Camper Conduct & Behavior Policy

It is our intent to keep all our campers safe and maintain a positive camp environment. Thank you for working with us to make the Lloyd Harbor Village Park Summer Camp the great experience it has always been for all of our children. We will not tolerate bullying, hitting or any other aggressive behavior. As such we are implementing a "Three Strikes" policy regarding violent, abusive and disrespectful behavior:

• First instance – Verbal warning from the child's counselor and a phone call from the Director to the parents to inform them of the offending behavior.

• Second instance – Camper will be removed from all camp activities, brought to the camp office and parents will be called to pick-up their child immediately. Offending camper will be suspended for the remainder of the camp day or the entire next day depending on the time of the offending behavior.

• Third instance – Expulsion from camp for the remainder of the season. Any remaining camp weeks will be forfeited and no refunds will be given.

We are confident that this policy will not have to be implemented and look forward to a rewarding and fun filled summer.

Clothing and Equipment

- Sneakers and play clothes over a swim suit.
- Water shoes (recommended).
- A towel.
- A life jacket (required for all 5th graders & Junior Recreation participants).
- A beach bag or other container, (please label all your child's belongings)
- A tennis racket & sneakers for tennis.
- Sunscreen.
- A lunch and a snack (if desired). Lunches can be refrigerated.
- Please send your child with adequate water every day.

<u>Please note</u>: DO NOT bring cell phones, game consoles or music players to camp. The Village is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged personal belongings.

*****Important Information for Children with Life Threatening Allergies****

In order for the Health Care Designee to allow a camper to have medication such as an inhaler or Epi-pen administered, the specific camper must provide written orders from the licensed prescriber. These orders must list the camper's name, description of the use of the medication, the dosage of the medication, the route for administration, and the medication must be in its original container. Parental permission by itself is not sufficient. Without these orders in place, 911 will be called in the event of a medical emergency.

If an Epi-pen is administered during camp, 911 will be called for follow up treatment at the nearest hospital.

Additional Information

- Please apply sunscreen to your child prior to camp each day.
- Counselors will reapply sunscreen during the day for younger children after their first swim session.
- We do not supply sunscreen.
- Please check our "Lost and Found" located near the Drop-Off / Pick-Up area periodically.
- Please provide your child with a bag lunch each camp day (except for Thursday).
- Pizza Lunch will be served to all campers every Thursday, please provide your child with adequate water. No glass containers please.
- Please make your child's counselors and the Camp Director are aware if your child has any special dietary restrictions such as Celiac Disease so we can best serve them.
- Please make sure all of your child's belongings are labeled with his/her name.
- Please make an effort to meet the staff members charged with your child's health & well-being while they are at camp. Parent/staff communication is a vital component to a positive camp experience.
