2020 HARBOR USE PERMIT

Enclosed are the **Harbor Use Permit** application and a summary of the regulations for operation of vessels in Lloyd Harbor.

Please note that <u>all vessels</u> moored, anchored, or rafted with other vessels must have a current Harbor use permit decal displayed at all times. <u>You must put your permit number on the upper part of your buoy and the number of the permit issued must correspond to the number on your buoy.</u>

Please note that vessels attached to yacht club or other boating association moorings are not required to display a harbor use decal; however, they must fly the club burgee. A maximum of 13 Club Permits will be issued.

Harbor Use Permits are issued on a first-come, first-served basis. There is a limit on the maximum number of permits issued. Therefore, it is suggested that you renew without delay. Please be advised that operators of vessels who have failed to answer a summons for infractions of the Waterways law will not have their permits renewed.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISPLAY OF 2020 HARBOR USE PERMIT

Please place your 2020 Harbor Use Permit decal on the port side of the hull, aft of the registration. If your vessel is documented, place it 1 foot from the bow.

Please be sure to have your Harbor Use Permit number **DISPLAYED** on the upper side of your mooring buoy.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE USE AND DISPLAY OF A GUEST HARBOR USE PERMIT

Also enclosed, for each resident and non-resident Harbor Use Permit holder, is one GUEST HARBOR USE PERMIT. This guest permit must be completely filled out by the regular harbor use permit holder, and is good for a single guest boat of no more than three consecutive days. You must be at your mooring or anchorage for this guest permit to be valid.

The GUEST HARBOR USE PERMIT should be displayed on the guest's boat windshield, cabin windows, or other locations where it will be clearly visible to the Harbor Patrol boat.

Additional guest permits can be obtained at the Village Park entrance for a fee of \$10.00 each.

THE VILLAGE'S HARBORMASTER DOES PATROL AND WILL ISSUE A TICKET FOR BOATS NOT DISPLAYING A CURRENT PERMIT.

HARBOR CONTROL COMMISSION REGULATIONS FOR OPERATION OF VESSELS IN LLOYD HARBOR

n order to share the waters of Lloyd Harbor safely and equably among all interested parties, the following egulations are in force:

- a. The Harbor is divided into a Channel, two Anchorages, a Transient Anchorage, a Ski Area and the Inner Harbor as shown on the chart on the back of this sheet.
- b. All vessels over 16' in length anchored, and all vessels moored or rafted outside of the Transient Anchorage must display a current Harbor Use Permit decai showing that their operators have obtained a Harbor Use Permit from the Harbor Master. Boats without Harbor Use Permit decals will be ticketed.
- c. No vessel may anchor or moor in the Channel or Water Ski Area nor be on a mooring in the Transient Anchorage.
- d. A 5 knot speed limit applied everywhere except in the Water Ski Area when towing skiers. NOTE: Jet skiers are not water skiers and must obey the limit.
- e. Overnight occupancy is prohibited within 300° of m.h.w. and west of the end of the Channel (in the Inner Harbor). Overnight rafting is limited to 3 boats on a mooring or anchor.
- f. Propulsion of any vessel except by hand or sail is prohibited within the Inner Harbor without a permit such as for a dock, mooring, shellfishing, etc.
- g. Any vessel anchored or on a mooring without visible evidence of a current Harbor Use Permit will be ticketed (just like an illegally parked car).
- h. Vessels on a Club mooring are not required to have Harbor Use Permit but must observe the overnight rafting limit and fly the Club burgec.
- Lloyd Harbor is a New York State designated "No Discharge Zone" and marine sanitation devices must be secured to prevent discharge in the Harbor.

The Harbor Patrol will monitor Channel 16 when on duty to respond to any calls from boats needing assistance.

Copies of the complete Waterways Law may be obtained from the Village Clerk. Your cooperation will ensure a pleasant boating season for all.
