*****IMPORTANT CAMP INFORMATION FOR LLOYD HARBOR RESIDENTS*****

- ***There will be no in person camp registration day for summer 2022.***
- Monday, March 7 through Friday, March 11. drop box will be available from 8 AM – 4 PM.
- Village Hall staff will NOT accept any forms/payments related to camp registration.
- Any camp registration received after Friday, March 11 will be considered late and subject to an additional \$50 per week, per child late fee.
- All payments must be in the form of a check or money order ONLY (no cash payments will be accepted).

***** REGISTRATION FEE IS NOT REFUNDABLE AFTER A CHILD IS ENROLLED. *****

SUMMER CLUB PROGRAM (Children ages 6 – 10, entering Grades 1-5 in September 2022):

- **\$325 per camper, per week. For registrations received between March 7 – 11 only.**
- **\$375 per camper per week. For ALL registrations received AFTER March 11.**

JUNIOR RECREATION PROGRAM (Children ages 10 – 13, entering Grades 6-8 in September 2022):

- **\$425 per camper, per week. For registrations received between March 7 – 11 only.**
- **\$475 per camper per week. For ALL registrations received AFTER March 11.**

CAMP DATES: Monday, June 27 – Friday, August 19, 2022 (No Camp on Monday, July 4, 2022)

DAYS & HOURS: Monday – Friday, 10 AM – 3 PM at Lloyd Harbor Village Park.

- Children must have the ability to function in an outdoor group setting with sandy, uneven terrain.
- Camp is not staffed to provide one-on-one attention.
- Please make sure your child is interested in and enthusiastic about these sorts of programs before registering.
- All activities depend on favorable weather.
- There will be no camp held on inclement weather days.
- Inclement weather cancellations will be determined by 9:00 am.

REQUIRED CAMP REGISTRATION PAPERWORK

Completed Camp Registration / Emergency Contact Information Form (One form for each child).

Child's most recent medical exam (dated no earlier than 2021). Forms MUST include an updated list of immunizations & doctor's signature. All forms MUST be submitted by May 21, 2022. No child will be permitted to attend camp without proper documentation.

Two proofs of Lloyd Harbor residency required: 1 -- Automobile registration with a valid Lloyd Harbor address. 2 -- Valid driver's license, tax bill, or deed.	
<i>Parking permits will be available at Lloyd Harbor Village Hall (Monday through Friday) beginning January 3, 2022 and at the Village Park beginning Saturday, May 14, 2022.</i>	

GUEST PARKING PERMITS

2022 Guest Parking Permit: \$10 Per Vehicle	2 Permit Limit, Per Resident, Per Day
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Guest Passes may not be purchased by Lloyd Harbor residents without a valid 2022 parking permit.• All guests must be accompanied by a Lloyd Harbor resident for entry into the park.• Guest parking permit must be prominently displayed on the vehicle dashboard.	
Note: On Monday, July 4, 2022 - No guest permits will be sold or honored after 7:30 PM.	

HARBOR USE / BOAT RACK PERMITS

All motorized watercraft using the Village Park ramp are required to have a permit sticker.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Harbor Use Permits \$50 / Boat Rack Permits (for storage of kayaks & dinghies) \$40• Harbor Use Permits & Boat Rack Permits are only available at Lloyd Harbor Village Hall.
<i>Note: All boats / watercraft must be removed from the park by December 1, 2022</i>

FAMILY PARTIES

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All parties are subject to Lloyd Harbor Village Park regulations.• Party host must be a Lloyd Harbor resident in attendance and possess a valid 2022 parking permit.• For parties of more than 25 guests, a \$100 fee is payable in advance.• Guest parking permit rules apply to all vehicles of non-residents that will be in attendance.• No private parties of over 75 people are permitted.• No parties are permitted on July 4th & Labor Day.• Call Genevieve Cimino, (631) 424-0051, at least 2 weeks before the event to make arrangements.

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CAMP REGISTRATION CHECKLIST 2022

- ✓ Registration for Lloyd Harbor Residents: March 7 – 11, 2022 via the drop box at Lloyd Harbor Village Hall (32 Middle Hollow Road, Huntington, NY).
- ✓ All registrations after March 11, 2022 must be mailed to Lloyd Harbor Village Hall.
- ✓ All registrations submitted after March 11, 2022 are subject to a \$50 late fee per child, per week.
- ✓ Complete the correct registration form based on your child's school grade level in the September 2022 (Summer Club: Grades 1 – 5 / Junior Recreation: Grades 6 – 8).
- ✓ Choose your camp weeks for each child carefully. **REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN FOR ANY REASON.**
- ✓ Complete the information on the Camp Registration form. (One form is required for each child). Failure to properly complete the registration form may result in an inability to obtain your preferred camp weeks.
- ✓ Indicate your first and second choices of preferred camp weeks.
- ✓ Sign and date the Recreation Program Release on the bottom of the Camp Registration Form.
- ✓ Complete the Emergency Contact Information form (located on the back of the Camp Registration Form).
- ✓ Check (and double check) that you are submitting the appropriate fee. (If you have multiple children attending camp, you may use one check for all your children).
- ✓ All payments must be made via check or money order. No cash payments will be accepted. Please make your check payable to: *Incorporated Village of Lloyd Harbor*
- ✓ If you are mailing in your registration (after March 11, 2022), please address your envelope the following way:

Camp on Inclement Weather Days:

- There will be no camp program held on inclement weather days.
- Inclement weather cancellations will be determined by 9:00 am.

Camp Drop-Off & Pick-Up Procedures

Drop-Off: Drop-off time is 10:00 AM. You may drop off your child at the drop off area by pulling up to a staff member who will assist them in getting out of your vehicle on the passenger side only. If you prefer, you can also park your vehicle and walk your child to his or her assigned group.

Pick-Up: Pick-up time is promptly at 3:00 PM. You MUST park your vehicle and pick up your child from his or her assigned group. Children may NOT enter the parking lot area at pick-up unattended.

Late Pick-Ups: If your child is not picked up by 3:10 PM we will call your emergency contact. There is a \$30 fee for implementing the emergency contact list and you will be billed. If you are late more than 2 times there will be a \$50 fee and next year's camp registration will be held back until all other residents have registered. Failure to pay the fee will result in loss of camp registration privileges for the following year.

Camper Conduct & Behavior Policy

It is our intent to keep all our campers safe and maintain a positive camp environment. Thank you for working with us to make the Lloyd Harbor Village Park Summer Camp the great experience it has always been for all of our children.

We will not tolerate bullying, hitting or any other aggressive behavior. As such we are implementing a "Three Strikes" policy regarding violent, abusive and disrespectful behavior:

- First instance – Verbal warning from the child's counselor and a phone call from the Director to the parents to inform them of the offending behavior.
- Second instance – Camper will be removed from all camp activities, brought to the camp office and parents will be called to pick-up their child immediately. Offending camper will be suspended for the remainder of the camp day or the entire next day depending on the time of the offending behavior.
- Third instance – Expulsion from camp for the remainder of the season. Any remaining camp weeks will be forfeited and no refunds will be given.

We are confident that this policy will not have to be implemented and look forward to a rewarding and fun filled summer.

Clothing and Equipment

- Sneakers and play clothes over a swimsuit.
- Water shoes (recommended).
- A towel.
- A life jacket (required for all 5th graders & Junior Recreation participants).
- A beach bag or other container, (please label all your child's belongings)
- A tennis racket & sneakers for tennis.
- Sunscreen.
- A lunch and a snack (if desired). Lunches can be refrigerated.
- Please send your child with adequate water every day.
- Label all your child's belongings with his/her name.

Please note: DO NOT bring cell phones, game consoles or music players to camp. The Village is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged personal belongings.

****** Important Information for Children with Life Threatening Allergies ******

In order for the Health Care Designee to allow a camper to have medication such as an inhaler or Epi-pen administered, the specific camper must provide written orders from the licensed prescriber. These orders must list the camper's name, description of the use of the medication, the dosage of the medication, the route for administration, and the medication must be in its original container. Parental permission by itself is not sufficient. Without these orders in place, 911 will be called in the event of a medical emergency.

If an Epi-pen is administered during camp, 911 will be called for follow up treatment at the nearest hospital.

Additional Information

- Apply sunscreen to your child prior to camp each day. Counselors will reapply sunscreen during the day for younger children after their first swim session.
- We do not supply sunscreen.
- Check our "Lost and Found" located near the Drop-Off / Pick-Up area periodically.
- Provide your child with a bag lunch each camp day (except for Friday).
- Pizza Lunch will be served to all campers every Friday, please provide your child with adequate water. No glass containers please.
- Make your child's counselors and the Camp Director are aware if your child has any special dietary restrictions such as Celiac Disease so we can best serve them.
- Label all of your child's belongings with his/her name.
- Make an effort to meet the staff members charged with your child's health & well-being while they are at camp. Parent/staff communication is a vital component to a positive camp experience.
