Recycling Collection

Garbage Collection

All garbage must be in covered containers not to exceed 32 gallon capacity; weight limit **50 lbs.** Empty containers must be removed by the evening of the collection day. All garbage must be out by 7AM

Bulk items: Please only place one bulk item out with your regular garbage each week on your 2nd pick-up day Thursday. Only one item will be taken at that time.

Example: Chair, Table, Mattress, Box spring... Maximum height and width 4' Maximum weigh 50lbs. Carpet must be rolled and tied.

Residents + contractors are responsible for removal of all construction debris, bathroom fixtures and all yard waste.

LARGE METAL ITEMS (stoves, refrigerators, etc.) may be disposed of by appointment with the Highway Department. Please call Highway Department at 549-8880 to set up a pick-up date.

Scheduled E-waste Collection

There is a statewide ban on the disposal of certain electronics as trash. These items must be recycled.

Call the Highway/ Refuse Department at 549-8880 to schedule a collection of electronics covered by the law. You should place the electronic waste Outside the house by 7: am on your schedule date.

Christmas tree collection: Starts the second Thursday in January
