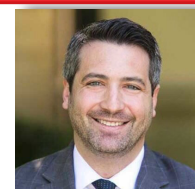

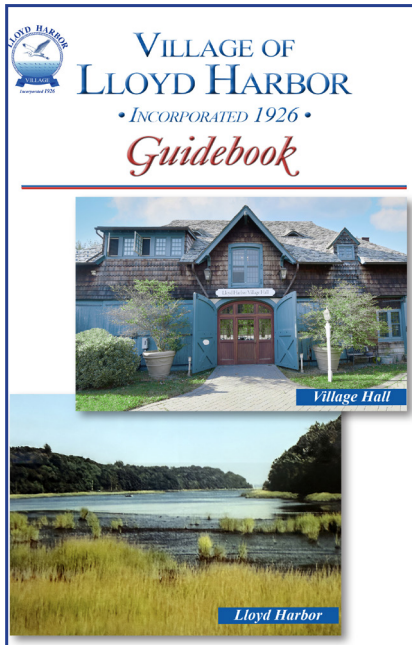

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

New signage at all Village entrances! The Highway Department worked with sign company (Eclipse Signs, Northport), turning design inspiration ("rustic elegance", provided by a great friend of the Village) into reality, determined best placement in some tough locations, and oversaw installation.



Repaving of Seminary Hill, under direction of the Highway Department has just been completed, following the excellent paving job that was done last year on SNAKE HILL ROAD. Line striping & lettering on various roads is scheduled for later in the season.

HARBOR CONTROL COMMISSION

The Harbor Control Commission, chaired by Peter Breitstone, has launched the best season yet. Professional Harbormasters Davanzo, Humenny, Werner & Rowan are all Peace Officers, able to offer assistance and enforce Village & Maritime regulations. Their presence provides order and calm enjoyment for boaters on all Village waterways.



RECREATION COMMISSION

Under direction & planning of the Recreation Commission, Marie Strunk & Beth Packert Co-Chairs, the Centennial Summer is in full swing at our beautiful Village Park! We are indebted to the visionary Village Trustees who, in 1959, orchestrated the purchase of this magnificent 73 acres of beachfront, meadow & woodland for purposes of a Village park & playground.

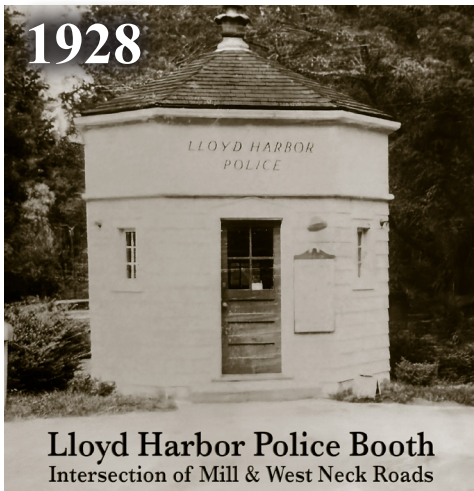

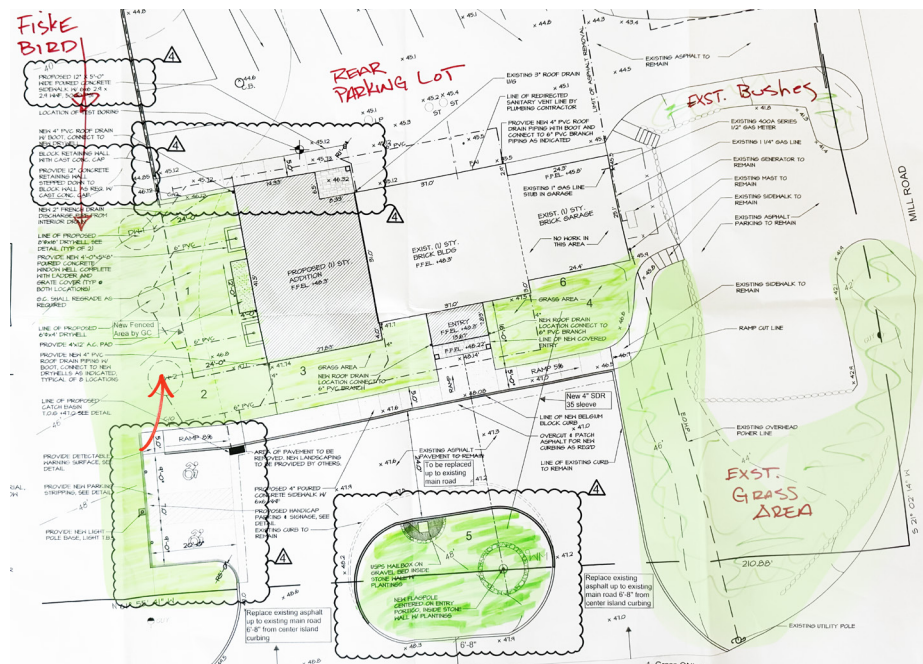


Lloyd Harbor Police Department's new Station House is near completion. The LHPD was relocated to the Seminary well in advance of commencement of construction, in order to have both a seamless technical transition and avoid the great expense & inconvenience of operating out of trailers. The contract was bid twice, resulting in savings of approximately \$700,000. **Building Consultant James Siino** has done a terrific job of overseeing the entire project.

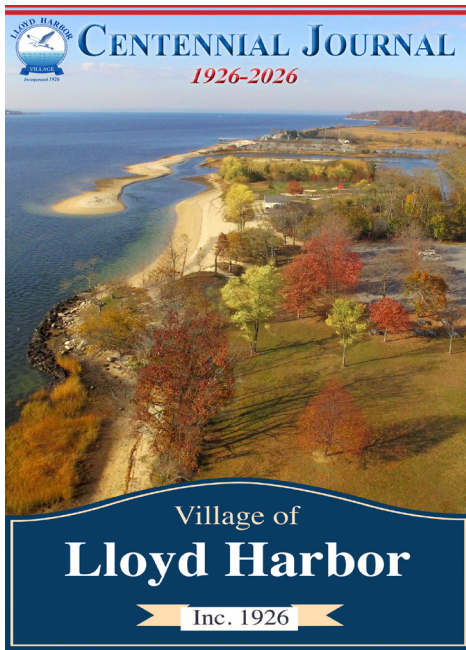
Landscaping & installation is being donated by Kean Development.

Conservation Advisory Commission

The CAC will focus on the left side of the Station House (facing building) which slopes down to a woodland entrance to Fiske Pond. **Corine Perrotta (Chair) & Lisa deGuzman**, have worked with Kean Development's landscape architect, Tony Rubino, to source native plantings suitable for the location. The result will be a lovely transition from the beautiful, more structured foundation landscaping in the front of the building, to an inviting, relaxed & natural look incorporating native plant material such as Christmas Fern, Blue Mist Flower, Sea Oats & Switchgrass.



Centennial Journal



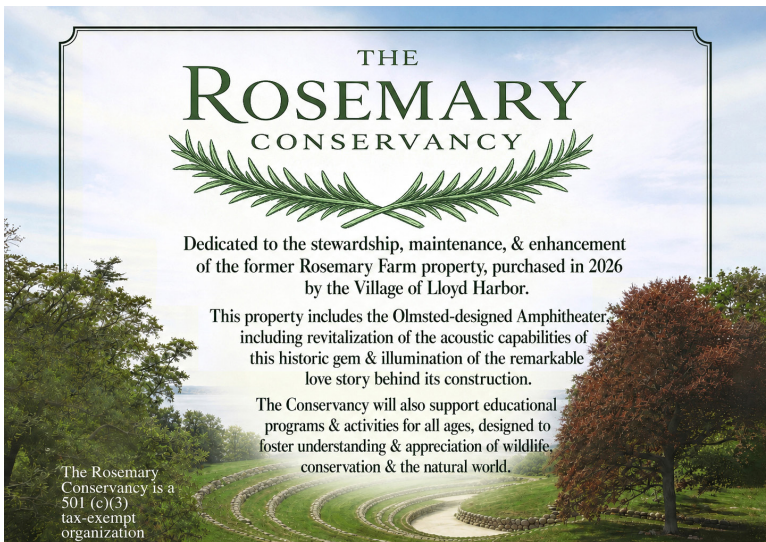

Rosemary Farm

In 2026, after almost four years of strategizing and often difficult negotiations, the Village finalized purchase, from the Seminary, of over 20 acres of Rosemary Farm. The other owners include the Seminary (which retains its building & grounds totaling 16 acres,) and NY State (which owns 180 acres spanning the perimeter of the property and steep slopes to the water, purchased with an EPA bond.) **The Village's parcel includes the magnificent, Olmsted-designed Amphitheater. This purchase is a spectacular addition to Village holdings.**

The Rosemary Conservancy has been established to help provide support for the Village's Rosemary Farm acquisition.
