The public meeting and hearing is being held in accordance with Executive Order 202.1

The hearing will be on the 2020/2021 budget of estimated expenses and revenues for the Village's fiscal year commencing 6/1/20 and ending 5/31/21 which has been prepared by the Board of Trustees. The budget shows no compensation to the Mayor and Trustees.

This proposed budget is on file with the Village Clerk and open to the public for inspection on prior notice to the Village Clerk (jcervini@lloydharbor.org), from the date of this notice until the time of the hearing. The public meeting of the Board of Trustees will be held to consider, address and take required action on Village matters.

All persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard by telephone on the teleconference during the hearing and may listen to the meeting. All citizens have a right to participate in the teleconference of the public hearing and to provide written comments by email or regular mail to the Village Clerk, which are received prior to the commencement of public hearing, make oral comments and to ask questions on the teleconference concerning the proposed Village budget. Public comments received prior to the commencement of the public hearing will be made part of the public record. The transcript/minutes of the hearing and meeting will be available at a later date.
