RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS

ALL RECYCLABLES MUST BE CLEAN & IN SEPARATE CONTAINERS - NO PLASTIC BAGS

GLASS:

Include: Only household bottles, jars used for food, liquids, beverages, soda and water – <u>must be rinsed clean</u>

Exclude: Ceramics, drinking glasses, plate glass, mirrors, lightbulbs, auto glass and dishware – <u>place these</u> items with regular trash

METAL AND PLASTIC COLLECTION:

Include: Only household containers, food and beverage cans, aluminum disposable pans, Plastic shampoo, and detergent bottles, etc. - <u>must be rinsed clean</u>

Exclude: Plastic bags, plastic wrap, plastic toys, oil cans, empty paint cans, aerosols, styrofoam, batteries, medical waste, plastic housewares, hangers, flower pots, etc. - place these items with your regular garbage.

PAPER AND CARDBOARD:

Include: Telephone books, junk mail, school paper, clean scrap paper, gift boxes, cereal boxes (remove plastic liner) detergent, pasta and shoe boxes, etc., (remove plastic windows, if any, from boxes), unsoiled newspapers, magazines, junk mail, corrugated shipping boxes. All material must be tied into bundles no more than 12" high or put into PAPER grocery bags. CARDBOARD BOXES must be flattened and tied into bundles no longer than 2' x 2' x 4'

Exclude: Tissues, soiled paper, paper towels, milk, juice and egg cartons, all wax coated boxes, books, gift boxes, pizza boxes, etc. <u>Include these items with your regular garbage</u>.

E-Waste Collection:

Since January 1, 2015, there is a statewide ban on the disposal of electronics as trash, i.e. VCRs, DVD players, digital converter boxes, cable or satellite receivers, video game consoles, televisions, cathodes, computers, monitors, keyboards, fax machines, document scanners and printers, etc. **These items must be recycled**. Please contact the Highway & Sanitation Department at (631) 549-8880 to schedule your E-Waste collection.

LARGE METAL ITEMS:

For a small fee, (stoves, refrigerators, Mowers etc.) may be disposed of by appointment with the Highway Department. Please call (631) 549-8880 to set up a pick-up date.

Residents and/or contractors are responsible for removal of all construction debris, bathroom fixtures and all yard waste.
